# THE ORGANISATION OF THE ALJ

- Created in 1984
- 10 regional offices with 14,75 posts of social pedagogues
- 40 teachers attached to secondary schools with régime préparatoire
- Regional offices outside of secondary schools

# MISSIONS OF THE ALJ

- **Prevention of early school leaving**
  - Interventions in classes (OSNA)
  - proactive approach to offer individual accompaniment
- **Individual accompaniment of early school leavers**
  - Since school year 2003/2004
- **Support and accompaniment of every youngster or young adult who asks for support**

# ASSISTANCE FOR EARLY SCHOOL LEAVERS

- A listing of the early school leavers every month
- Proactive approach by the ALJ
  - 1<sup>st</sup> contact by letter addressed to the parents
  - In case of non-response, the ALJ contacts the parents or the youngster
- Offer of accompaniment and support until the youngster has found a definite solution
- Interview for statistics

# INDIVIDUAL ACCOMPANIMENT OF EARLY SCHOOL LEAVERS

- Establish a school assessment
- Consider the life situation of the youngster
- Orientation to psychological, social or other services: establish contact, if desired; insure assistance if necessary
- Establish (new) professional project with alternatives
- Accompaniment in the realisation of the project
  - Internships in firms
  - Reinstatement in secondary school
  - Accompaniment in the search of an apprenticeship or employment

- × Step 4: My part in a company / Internship
- × Step 5: Staying motivated
